
AUBIC (SONGS FROM A GOLDEN AGE)

PROJECT



AURIC is a project made by UK-based 1st generation migrant artists and aimed at young migrants. We are remaking classical theatre in an accessible way to defy the boundaries of language and culture for equality and diversity.

We have exceeded our original goals, resulting in a live performance and workshop at FesteLon Spanish Theatre Festival at the Bush Theatre. We also created an accessible digital performance. Additionally, we hosted and filmed a Q&A after the performance and created a free digital workshop.


LIVE PERFORMNACE









ACCESSIBLE PERFORMANCE




We have updated and created new and more effective marketing materials, to continue promoting our work.
